## Four booked for hurling casteist slurs

Rajkot: Four people including a sarpanch and his brother were booked under Atrocities Act for allegedly hurling casteist slurs at people during an anti-encroachment drive in Shapar-Veraval village adjoining the city. The incident had happened on August 16 when Veraval sarpanch Ravirajsinh Jadeja's brother Gopalsinh had allegedly hurled abuses at people who were resisting the drive. Gopalsinh's videos went viral and one person named Bhavin Ranva, who received the clips on his mobile phone, approached his community leaders to lodge a complaint. When Ranva and others called up Jadeja, the latter and his other friends Govid Makwana and Ramesh Vaghela, again hurled epithets at them and spoke disparagingly about their caste. Ranva then lodged a complaint against the four with Shapar-Veraval police station. 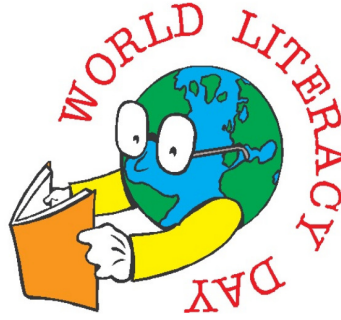

## GEDA gets six AREAS awards

Gandhinagar: Gujarat Energy Development Agency (GEDA), which functions under the climate change department, has bagged six awards at the Association of Renewable Energy Agencies of States (AREAS) foundation day event held at Cochin in Kerala on Saturday.

An official state government release said on Sunday that GEDA bagged six awards in the field of renewable energy at the function. AREAS operates under the Union ministry of new and renewable energy (MNRE). The awards were given for the year 2021-22 and handed over by Union minister of state for new and renewable energy Bhagwant Khuba. The government release said that GEDA was awarded first prize for adding the highest capacity through wind energy projects and second prize for installed capacity addition of wind power. The state also bagged awards for highest increase in solar power generation and second prize for installed capacity addition of renewable energy.

## Ahmedabad: Dabba trading operation busted

AHMEDABAD: Prevention of crime branch (PCB) sleuths on Tuesday busted an illegal dabba trading operation and arrested one man for illegal share trading from a flat in the Law Garden area of the city. Dabba trading is banned by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI).

According to the FIR filed with Ellisbridge police by PCB constable Indrasinh Pravinshin, police got an input that an illegal dabba trading operation was running from an office at Devnandan Mall in Ellisbridge.

Police went to office number 329 at the mall and detained one Kalpit Pandit, 44, a resident of Shreesadan Apartments in New Vasna. Cops found a laptop in Pandit's possession on which he was working on an application named 'Meta Traders', the FIR states.

Police said that Pandit was trading in the stock market through the application and was making spot trades. Police found him working on the laptop with stock prices displayed. Cops also found two mobiles on which Pandit was talking his to five accomplices who he had given accounts of 'Meta Traders' to make spot trades. During his questioning, Pandit told police that his aides would send him accounts on the trades and profits of clients.

## Real Gujarat poll battle between Congress, BJP

Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot on Wednesday sought to downplay the entry of Arvind Kejriwal's Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) into the Gujarat poll arena and claimed the real battle will be fought between his party Congress and the ruling BJP.

Expressing confidence about the Congress winning the Assembly polls due by the year-end, he attacked the

Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), saying people have now understood the "hollowness" of the famed 'Gujarat Model' of development. Talking to reporters in Vadodara, the senior Congress observer for the Gujarat Assembly elections said, "We are not concerned about the AAP's entry into Gujarat. Though they have come, the real battle will be between the Congress and the

BJP. The Congress is very strong in Gujarat and we will give a tough fight this time. I will not be surprised if the Congress forms the next government." AAP convener and Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal has been frequently visiting Gujarat and announcing pre-poll "guarantees". So far, he has announced pre-poll promises related to electricity, education, women empowerment and tribals, among others. Gehlot is on a two-day Gujarat visit from Wednesday during which he will hold meetings with state Congress leaders to review their preparedness for the upcoming Assembly polls. He started his Gujarat tour from Vadodara by holding a meeting with party leaders from the central Gujarat zone on Wednesday morning. He then reached Ahmedabad to hold a meeting with north Gujarat zone leaders. "Those who used to talk about the Gujarat Model have now become the PM (referring to Narendra Modi, who was earlier state CM). People have now understood the hollowness of this Gujarat Model because all their problems still persist. This model is now exposed and people want to now give a chance to the Congress," Gehlot told reporters ahead of the meeting here. "Last time (in 2017), we missed the (majority) mark by only a few seats in Gujarat. This time, we will give a tough fight and launch an impressive poll campaign. Despite tall claims of 'Feel Good' and 'India Shining', the Vajpayee government lost the Lok Sabha polls in 2004.
